7 Documents to Establish the Conformity of the Goods	7.1 The vendor shall furnish as part of its quotation the documentary evidence that the Non Consultancy conform to the technical specifications and standards specified in Section IV, “Technical Specifications & Compliance with Specifications”. 7.2 The documentary evidence may be in the form of literature, drawings or data, and shall consist of a detailed item by item description of the essential technical and performance characteristics of the Non Consultancy, demonstrating substantial responsiveness of the Non Consultancy to the technical specifications, and if applicable, a statement of deviations and exceptions to the provisions of the Technical Specifications given. 7.3 If stated in the Data Sheet the vendor shall submit a certificate from the manufacturer to demonstrate that it has been duly authorized by the manufacturer or producer of the Non Consultancy to supply these Non Consultancy in Sri Lanka.

9 Format and Signing of Quotation	9.1 The quotation shall be typed or written in indelible ink and shall be signed by a person duly authorized to sign on behalf of the vendor.

10 Submission of Quotation	10.1 Vendors may submit their quotations by mail or by hand in sealed envelopes addressed to the Purchaser bear the specific identification of the contract number. 10.2 If the quotation is not sealed and marked as required, the Purchaser will assume no responsibility for the misplacement or premature opening of the quotation.

12 Late Quotation	12.1 The Purchaser shall reject any quotation that arrives after the deadline for submission of quotations, in accordance with ITV Clause 11.1 above.
13 Opening of Quotations	13.1 The Purchaser shall conduct the opening of quotation in public at the address, date and time specified in the Data Sheet. 13.1 A representative of the bidders may be present and mark its attendance.

E: Evaluation and Comparison of Quotation	
14 Clarifications	14.1 To assist in the examination, evaluation and comparison of the quotations, the Purchaser may, at its discretion, ask any vendor for a clarification of its quotation. Any clarification submitted by a vendor in respect to its quotation which is not in response to a request by the Purchaser shall not be considered. 14.1 The Purchaser's request for clarification and the response shall be in writing.
15 Responsiveness of Quotations	15.1 The Purchaser will determine the responsiveness of the quotation to the documents based on the contents of the quotation received. 15.2 If a quotation is evaluated as not substantially responsive to the documents issued , it may be rejected by the Purchaser.
16 Evaluation of quotation	16.1 The Purchaser shall evaluate each quotation that has been determined, to be substantially responsive. 16.2 To evaluate a quotation, the Purchaser may consider the following: (a) the Price as quoted; (b) price adjustment for correction of arithmetical errors; (a) price adjustment due to discounts offered. 16.3 The Purchaser's evaluation of a quotation may require the consideration of other factors, in addition to the Price quoted if stated in Section II, Data Sheet. 3. Coverage Requirement

3.2 All Insurers are required to provide the above information by using the format given in Section III Schedule of Requirements. (non –compliance is a ground for rejection of submitted quotation).

3.3 The Fire Insurance Policy period is required for a period of **1 year effective from the award date.**

4. QUALIFICATIONS / REQUIREMENTS OF THE SERVICE PROVIDER:

- 4.1 The service provider should be an Insurance Company serving the general insurance category that is registered at the Insurance Regulatory Commission of Sri Lanka and at least 05 years of experience in the field of Fire insurance services sector is a must.
- 4.2 list of current clients under similar services category and list of clients for last three Years.
- 4.3 Responsiveness of personnel: Indication of company focal person with relevant experience.
- 4.4 Registration certificates: Company profile, Copy of Business registration, copy of registration at Insurance Regulatory Commission and Copy of VAT registration.
- 4.5 for the last three years audited financial statements.
- 4.6 Co-ordinating and reporting:
The service provider will submit a bi-annual report to Sri Lanka CERT (Pvt) Ltd, HR division showing the claims.
- 4.7 Financial summary form:
The service provider should indicate all the benefit features and proposed charges for the premium and ceiling using Section V Quotation Submission form and Price Schedule attached to the Bid document.

5. SETTLEMENT OF THE CLAIM

- 5.1 In the event of a loss or damage covered under the insurance policy, the successful bidder shall indemnify the insured for the full replacement value of the affected asset(s) specified in Annex 1.
- 5.2 The insurer shall process and settle all valid claims within fourteen (14) calendar days from the date of submission of all required claim documents and completion of the claim assessment process.
- 5.3 Any delay in claim settlement beyond the stipulated period shall be communicated to the insured in writing, together with the reasons for such delay and the expected date of settlement.

6. EXCLUSIONS

- 6.1 The bidder shall clearly specify all exclusions, limitations, conditions, and exceptions applicable to the insurance coverage requested by Sri Lanka CERT as detailed in Table 1 of SECTION III.
- 6.2 Any exclusion, limitation, condition, or exception not expressly stated in the bidder's proposal shall be deemed not applicable. In such instances, Sri Lanka CERT shall consider that the bidder has fully complied with and accepted all coverage requirements specified in Table 1 of SECTION III without restriction.
